We are delighted to welcome you to the MGS Junior School. Our award-winning building is home to boys aged 9 to 11, providing them with a secure and friendly environment, where they will benefit from small class sizes. In September 2011, we open our doors to boys from the age of 7, providing the complete junior experience.



We have a strong and effective partnership with the Senior School, both in terms of shared facilities and specialist teaching. MGS boys develop all the fundamental learning skills, but without constant repetition; bright boys thrive on enrichment, investigation and variety.

Our primary staff and specialists offer the expertise and passion to take the boys beyond normal expectations. Our options programme offers a range of activities, from the design of working robots to developing skills as future business entrepreneurs. Music, sport, art and drama also offer opportunities for our children to shine.

There is no entrance examination for admission into the Junior School. Instead boys will spend a day with us as part of a small group. We observe their individual talents in imaginative lessons and group tasks, enabling us to get a 'real feel' for the boy himself. This allows every boy

to start from the same point, regardless of his previous experience, with automatic entry into the Senior School at the end of Year 6.

Although part of the wider MGS community, our boys still experience the nurture and care of primary-trained form teachers. Every boy is special and it is our role to know how to support him and build confidence. Our sixth formers are a vital part of this process, providing fun, friendship and the support of a big brother. Our wrap-around-care service also ensures that boys are happy and safe outside school hours.

Our aim is for boys to arrive in the Junior School with a sense of anticipation and to leave still buzzing. Every day is precious in giving opportunities for able boys to grow and push out their own boundaries.
